Spend some time this week looking at next Sunday's readings. It's a great way to prepare for worship & build a personal spiritual discipline of regular bible reading.



Altar Flowers Sponsorship Update (Effective 2026) -

For many years, members of our parish have generously sponsored altar flowers in thanksgiving or in memory of loved ones. We're grateful for this quiet but meaningful ministry that adds beauty to our worship week by week.

Beginning in January 2026, the cost to sponsor altar flowers for a Sunday will increase from \$35 to \$45. This change reflects the actual cost of the floral arrangements, which has risen over time. Updating the amount allows us to continue this tradition sustainably and with care for our resources.

As always, altar flower sponsorships are an invitation, not an obligation. If this change would create a financial hardship for you and you would still like to sponsor flowers, please know you are welcome to speak with Mo. Alissa—we're glad to find a way to make this accessible.




